TOUR MINISTRY

- Two days of ministry with Israel’s top Evangelist, Jacob Damkani, and special prayer time with people from around the world at the Jerusalem Prayer Tower.

TOUR SITES

- Travel up the coast to Caesarea on the Sea. Caesarea (Acts 10 and 25), ancient city that was built in honor of Augustus Caesar by Herod the Great and view the Roman Amphitheater, Hippodrome and Aqueducts.
- Walk up to Tel Megiddo and overlook the Valley of Megiddo where the battle of Armageddon will take place.
- Drive through Cana of Galilee, where Jesus performed His first miracle of turning water into wine.
- Visit Nazareth, boyhood home of Jesus. Step back into time in Nazareth and walk in a 1st century village. Walk through an open-air museum that reconstructs and reenacts village life in the time of Jesus.
- Take a morning boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and have lunch at Peter’s Restaurant.
- Be inspired on the Mt. of Beatitudes.
- Capernaum – town of Jesus – was His ministry headquarters for 18 months

- Tabgha – where Jesus fed the multitudes with 5 loaves and 2 fishes
- Gather on the Jordan River for an anointed baptism service.
- Tel Dan Nature Park – a city mentioned in the Bible, belonging to the tribe of Dan.
- Caesarea Philip (Banias)
- Mt. Carmel Monastery where Elijah engaged in the contest with the false prophets of Baal
- Golan Heights – area captured from Syria during the 6-day war and now occupied by Israel
- Qumran – see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947.
- En Gedi National Park – where David hid from Saul. Enjoy many unusual, adorable animals that run through the park; so have your camera ready!
- Masada – Jewish defenders made their final stand in an unsuccessful revolt against Rome.
- Dead Sea –1,288 feet below sea level, enjoy floating in the sea
- Beit She ‘an – an ancient Decapolis Roman city with extensive excavations where the bodies of Saul and Jonathan were displayed by the Philistines.
- St George Monastery
- Genesis Land - meet father Abraham and hear about his legendary hospitality. Have lunch at his home under a tent and ride camels.
- Jerusalem – Visit the Mt. of Olives and behold the breath-taking panorama of the Holy City.
- Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed the night before His crucifixion
- The Upper Room on Mt. Zion where 12 disciples gathered to receive the Last Supper and 120 gathered to receive the outpouring of the Holy Spirit
- King David’s Tomb
- Western Wall Tunnel, which runs under the city along the Western Wall
- Pool of Bethesda – where Jesus healed the man at the pool
- St. Ann’s Church – believed to be named after Mary’s mother
- Via Dolorosa – following the steps of Jesus to the Holy Sepulcher
- Western Wall – the Jews most sacred site. Bring your prayer request and place it in the wall. Spend time in prayer ...
- Temple Mount – one of the most important religious sites in the Old City of Jerusalem and the entire world. It is also known as Mt. Moriah, the site traditionally viewed as the location where Abraham offered his son Isaac as a sacrifice and the known location of two Jewish Temples. Jesus will reign from the Temple Mount for 1,000 years.
- Eastern Gate – see the gate which is sealed, awaiting the Messiah’s return
- The southern steps of the Second Temple where Jesus walked as He entered the Temple
- Davidson Center – The Jerusalem Archaeological Park
- The city of Bethlehem, site of the birth of Jesus, the Church of the Nativity and the Shepherd’s Field
- Yad Vashem – Israel’s memorial to the 6 million Jews who were killed in the Holocaust.

- Visits to various local ministries that CFN supports.
